Loke leather



Loke is a buffed, embossed ox hide with a coated surface.

The hides used for this type of leather are selected for their uniform thickness and are embossed to achieve a uniform surface texture showing minimum visible scars or other marks. A top coating is added to give the leather a protective layer.

Leathers of this type have a pleasant feel with low breathability. The advantages of Loke is its low maintenance, its realatively lower cost compared to semi-aniline or full grain leathers, its resisence to staining and to fading in sunlight.

Carl Hansen & Søn recommend this type of leather for contract use such as in restarants, hotels and public spaces where low maintanence is required.

Loke is suitable for use on residential furniture with upholstered seat pads such as dining chairs. It is less well suited for use on soft upholstery such as sofas and large easy chairs.
